

Awards & Scholarships

The Cindy Yang Dancing Society of Vancouver, Canada established the Cindy Yang Memorial Fund to recognize and encourage fervent individuals of Chinese dance and culture to pursue further education, exchange in studies abroad, and participate in competitions. All enrolled students meeting criteria below are eligible for scholarship assessment.

Outstanding Progress Award

The Outstanding Progress Award recognizes students who show remarkable growth and improvement in their execution of dance techniques and passion for performance.

Foundational Requirements:

- Students who have studied Chinese dance for a minimum of two years, with a CDGES grade level of 3 or above.
- Achieved an attendance rate and punctuality of 90% or above.

Proficiency and Professional Requirements (Instructor Assessment):

- Students who have attained "忧" (excellent) in the Chinese Dance Graded Examinations are given priority.
- Significant improvement in overall performance.

Volunteer Contributions:

 Actively participating in Society's activities including, but not limited to charity performances and fundraising events.

Class of Excellence Award

The Class of Excellence Award acknowledges a class that shows significant improvement throughout the entire group, demonstrating active engagement in learning and mutual assistance among peers.

Foundational Requirements:

- Achieved a collective attendance rate and punctuality of 90% or above.
- Significant improvement observed throughout the entire group, demonstrating active engagement in learning and mutual assistance among peers.

Cindy Yang Excellence Award

The Cindy Yang Excellence Award with scholarship is presented to students who demonstrate high standards of dedication, technical prowess, leadership and participation within the Society.

Foundational Requirements:

- Students who have studied Chinese dance for a minimum of two years, with a grade level of 10-13 or above.
- Achieved an attendance rate and punctuality of 90% or above.

Proficiency and Professional Requirements (Instructor Assessment):

- Attained an assessment of "良" (proficient) or above in the Chinese Dance Graded Examinations.
- Demonstrates a positive learning attitude, active participation, excellent execution of movements, mutual assistance with peers, and the ability to motivate peers.

Volunteer Contributions:

 Actively participating in Society's activities including, but not limited to charity performances and fundraising events.

Inspirational Award

The Inspirational Award celebrates a student who exemplifies technical proficiency but also exceptional qualities, dedication, and positive impact that inspire peers, instructors, and the broader members of the Society.

Foundational Requirements:

• Achieved an attendance rate and punctuality of 90% or above.

Proficiency and Professional Requirements (Instructor Assessment):

- Attained an assessment of "良" (proficient) or above in the Chinese Dance Graded Examinations.
- Demonstrates a positive learning attitude, active participation, excellent execution of movements, mutual assistance with peers, and the ability to motivate peers.
- Demonstrate exemplary and inspirational characteristics to peers and other Society members.
